- Working Holiday Authorisations for citizens of Argentina are valid for presentation at an Irish port of entry within twelve months of the date of issue;
- Within one month of arrival in Ireland, holders of Working Holiday Authorisations must register with the Garda National Immigration Bureau and will be issued with a Certificate of Registration on payment of the appropriate fee;
- Working Holiday Authorisations are issued on an individual basis. Holders of Working Holiday Authorisations shall not seek to be accompanied or joined by a spouse or dependents;
- Permission granted to those entering Ireland on the basis of a Working Holiday Authorisation shall be valid for a maximum period of twelve (12) months from the date of entry into Ireland. Extensions to the period of validity of such permission shall not be granted. Participants must leave Ireland on the expiration of the permission, which cannot be extended, either under the authorisation itself, or through attempting to convert it to a different form of immigration status;

- **Argentine nationals who are already in Ireland with an immigration status other than that based on a Working Holiday Authorisation may not convert to permission based on a Working Holiday Authorisation without leaving the State and re-entering on the basis of the valid Working Holiday Authorisation.**
- **All questions have been answered and the particulars provided are true and correct to the best of my knowledge.**

### **DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED**

**The completed and signed application form should be presented at the Embassy of Ireland in Buenos Aires together with:**

- **Valid Argentine passport;**
- **2 recent identical passport photographs with your name on the reverse;**
- **Current curriculum vitae (with references);**
- **Original bank statement showing that you have access to €1,500 (or equivalent) plus a return ticket; or €3,000 (or equivalent);**
- **Originals of any qualifications obtained or letter from school/college/university (where applicable);**
- **A Police Certificate of Good Conduct (*Certificado de Antecedentes*)**

**Once the Embassy is satisfied with the documentation above, the application will be approved in principle and the applicant notified. The Working Holiday Authorisation will be issued on submission by the applicant of:**

- **Return airline tickets;**
- **Certificate of medical/travel insurance valid for the duration of the trip (based on dates on tickets)**
- **Valid Argentine passport that is valid for the entirety of the trip to Ireland ie for a full year after their ticketed date of entry.**
